The Northwoods Wildlife and Wetlands Club will host its annual Sight In Day at the NWWC public shooting range at 834 Range Rd, off Hwy 51, 3.5 miles south of Mercer, on Friday November 21st from 8am to 5pm. This is the day before the gun deer hunting opener.

Sight in Day is a free event and open to the public. The NWWC members include professional armorers, gunsmiths, and experience hunters who will assist zeroing in your rifle and any other issues presented. Spotting scopes, free targets, hearing protection, food and beverages, and a marshaled range are provided free of charge. Donations are welcomed.
